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Wedding Receptions at The Chainbridge Hotel

For wedding receptions at The Chainbridge, the hotel charges £195.00, which is in addition to the fees charged by the registrar on the day. We are covered by Ruthin registrar, who you can contact on 01824 706187 to discuss their availability & fees. To our knowledge, they would charge approximately

£275.00.

Dining options for weddings at The Chainbridge Hotel

Canapés

£1.50 per canapé, with a general recommendation of 3 canapés per guest

Starters

Chef's homemade soup of your choice, served with a crusty roll (v)

Ham hock terrine with a pickled gherkin garnish & Melba toast

Oven baked figs stuffed with goat's cheese, finished with a balsamic glaze (v)

Smoked haddock risotto topped with rocket leaves (v)

Confit duck leg with cranberry jus & dressed salad garnish

Mains

Poached chicken with bacon lardons & potato gratin & seasonal vegetables

Oven baked cod wrapped in smoked salmon, with new potatoes & seasonal vegetables

Penne pasta with roast cherry tomatoes, garlic, chilli & sesame oil with parmesan shavings (v)

Beef medallions with sautéed wild mushrooms in a red wine sauce, dauphinoise potatoes & seasonal vegetables

Pressed belly pork with roast potatoes, port apple puree & seasonal vegetables

Desserts

Spiced poached pear with Chantilly cream & honeycomb crumbs

Vanilla pannacotta with a raspberry compote

Individual meringue topped with seasonal fruit & homemade chocolate sauce

Homemade Bailey's cheesecake with a chocolate twist

Apple & rhubarb crumble & custard

From this menu the bridal party would need to select three of each course to offer guests, or should the bridal party prefer, we can offer just one option for each course, thus eliminating the requirement for choices etc.

We require guests to pre-order their meal choices before the wedding, and our chefs require a list of the selected dishes a minimum of one week before the big day. We are happy to provide a spreadsheet if this helps.

Banquet buffet

Children

Of course, children (which we class as young ones under the age of 12!) are most welcome at weddings. We are happy to discuss dining requirements and pricing for children on a one-by-one basis, to ensure that we provide the most suitable options available.

Glass of bubbly for welcome, toast or speeches £4.95 per glass

Glass of medium house wine (red or white) £4.95 per glass

Bottle of house wine (red or white) £17.95 per bottle

Jug of apple, orange or grapefruit juice £5.00 per jug

Function Room

Our Function Room, which overlooks the beautiful River Dee, has been improved recently and now has a stunning fibre optic ceiling & a newly installed bar. The Function Room has floor to ceiling windows to make the most of the room's location on the banks of the river, and also has a dance floor for your after dinner celebration.

The capacity of the Function Room is 100 for a formal sit down meal, and 150 for a less formal buffet, and after party.

The cost for the hire and exclusive use of the Function Room is £995.00. As well as providing your wedding party with sole use of the room, this cost covers hire and use of your choice of wedding crockery, cutlery, glassware, banqueting chairs and linen.

Accommodation

I would gladly provide the wedding couple with complimentary accommodation on the night of your wedding. This would be offered in Room 25, our four-poster room. If the wedding couple wished, they could upgrade to The Chainbridge Suite for a supplement of £150.00. Should additional nights be requested, The Chainbridge Suite is £250.00 per night.

In general the rooms are £99.95 for river view rooms with a balcony, and £89.95 per room for a canal side room. When people confirmed their rooms we would require a £25.00 per room deposit, to secure the booking. Unfortunately no promotional offers or discounts are offered to guests, if booking a number of rooms, or additional nights either side of the wedding etc, the tariff is adhered to.

Deposit

We ask that a minimum deposit of £500.00 is paid at the time of booking, and that the outstanding balance is paid one week prior to the wedding. Thank you.
